2015 COMMUNITY IMPACT REPORT

This is our report to you on the results of investments in Community Health Fund.

In 2015, workplace donations and support helped Community Health Fund's 13 community clinics touch the lives of over 310,000 people in the Twin Cities and Minnesota.

HEALTH

Need: 2 in 10 Minnesotans still struggle to find and afford adequate care for themselves and their families.

Our Impact:

- 179,000 families and individuals in the Twin Cities and Minnesota received the health care they need
- 8,600 individuals and families enrolled in health insurance
- 135,000 individuals learned about access health care services



ECONOMIC

Need: Inequities in health cost the U.S. more than \$85 billion last year in lost productivity and medical costs.

Our Impact:

- \$272 million saved in health care costs and reductions in work absences and productivity losses
- \$161 million generated in economic activity
- 265 new jobs for low income communities



BASIC NEEDS

Need: Over 730,000 people live at or near poverty in our community, experiencing challenges with hunger, homelessness, domestic violence and health.

Our Impact:

- 55,000 individuals and families connected with resources, including food and shelter
